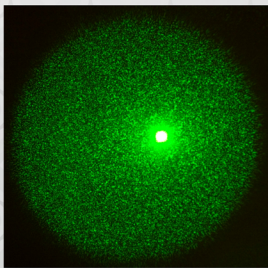
VENUE

Conference will take place at the Camino Real de Guanajuato Hotel, Gto., México.
Guanajuato, the capital of Mexico's state of Guanajuato, is one of UNESCO World Heritage Sites and a charming colonial-era city situated in a picturesque valley surrounded by the mountains of the "Sierra de Guanajuato". The region is known as the "Bajío", the heartland of Mexico.
The city hosts the annual Cervantino Festival, a festival of performing arts that is named in honor of Miguel de Cervantes Saavedra, author of Don Quixote. You will also find a museum dedicated to Don Quixote, and statues of him and his sidekick, Sancho Panza, in the Allende Plaza just outside "Teatro Cervantes" (Cervantes Theater).

CONFERENCE FORMAT

The conference will be single-session. One or two poster sessions will be scheduled, depending on the number of submissions.

The official language of the conference is English.

Time allowed for oral presentations is 15 minutes plus 5 minutes for questions and discussion.

Authors will be asked to indicate their preference for oral or poster presentation at the time of the abstract submission. Since there will be no parallel sessions, the number of oral presentations is limited to about 60. Therefore, the final decision will be taken by the chairs and the Scientific Committee.
